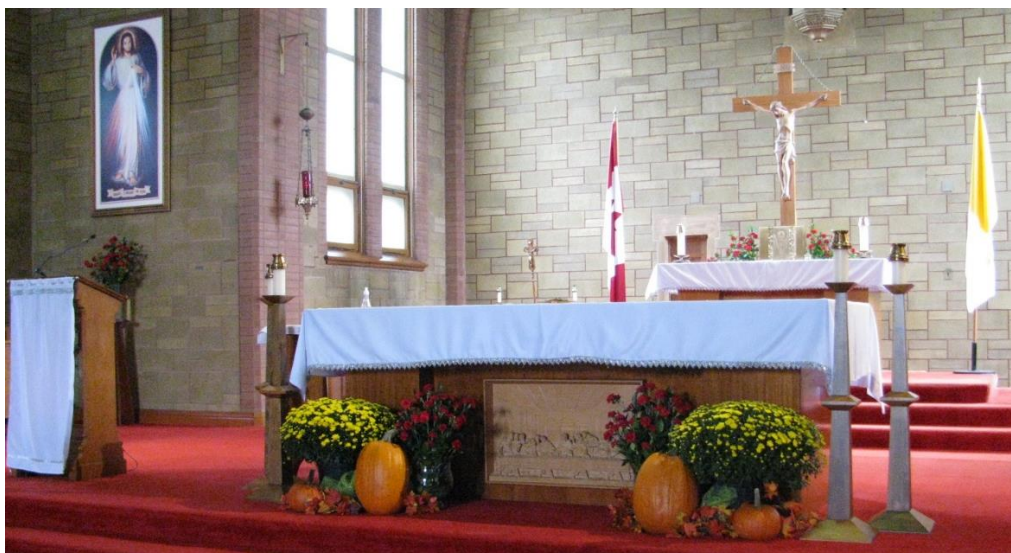

ENTHRONEMENT OF THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS IN CHRISTIAN HOME

DEFINITION AND LAST END

Following all that we have already said, we are now ready to define this Devotion, saying that it is 'the official and social recognition of the lovely Royalty of the Sacred Heart of Jesus in a Christian home' It is a recognition, meaning to say an acceptance, a free action, deliberate and official.

It is made in a solemn way by the head of the household; and it is a social action because it is an act with sensible implications toward the community as the head by the law in a house decides to abdicate in favour of another, who compromises to lead the members of the household in a safer way to the last end of life: heaven.

Thus, through an act of total surrender, we will fulfil what Saint John Henry Newman said: 'God has created me to do Him a service. He has given me a task that had not given to another person. I have my mission so I have to trust in Him, at any time and at any post I would be. I cannot go backward. If I am sick, my sickness can serve Him; if I am perplexed, my perplexity can serve him; if I suffer, my suffering can serve Him'
