- With great joy we announce the **BEATIFICATION OF THE PRIEST FR. MICHAEL J. MCGIVNEY**, founder of the Knights of Columbus, on October 31st, 2020. He was the parish priest at the archdiocese of Hartford in the USA, where 138 years ago he founded the Knights of Columbus to serve in the spiritual and material needs of that time. Today the Knights of Columbus is the world's largest Catholic fraternal service organization, with more the 2 million members.
- And to conclude our information's section of the **ENTHRONEMENT OF THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS** let us summarize the doctrine we have been explaining lately to arrive to a final conclusion:
 - 1- The Enthronement of the image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus in every home is an official and social act of recognition of the kingship of the Sacred Heart of Jesus in a Catholic family;
 - 2- It has as its final goal or objective to lead the members of the domestic society (household) to where Jesus reigns, to the final goal of our life: to heaven
 - 3- It aims to establish committed Catholics, who do not have an objection to surrender their own lives for the spreading of the Gospel of Jesus Christ, the only one who saves
 - 4- A logic consequence of this mission or apostolate will be the making of a renewed Christianity out of our modern society, it is the restoration of the whole social order in Christ; this demands the fidelity of those who declared Jesus the King of their household;
 - 5- Thus if Christ achieves to become the King of hearts, of the families, institutions and of the same social order in its wholeness, we do not need to await for the arrival of the Kingdom of heaven because our heaven would begin already on earth since where Christ reigns, God is the centre of everything and so, is it not that the same Paradise?
