(Feast: April 30)

Wife and Mother

Her parents chose Claude Martin as their daughter's husband. The young couple was blessed with the birth of a son, whom they called Claude after the father.

Her husband's premature death left Marie a widow at age 19 with a six-month old baby to care for.

A Second Call

Marie entered the Ursuline Monastery of Tours in 1631 and completed the different stages of formation.

In the days following Christmas 1634, a second dream left the young nun wondering. Soon, the Lord would confirm her intuition: "I want you to go to Canada to build a house for Jesus and Mary." In 1639, the road that would lead her to a country "as pitiful as it was frightful" would strangely resemble the difficult path she saw in her dream.





From this moment on, her prayers and zeal would extend across all borders, allowing her to accompany the missionaries: *"I tour the world in spirit, seeking all the souls redeemed by the most precious blood of my Divine Spouse."* Mary of the Incarnation was beatified on June 20th, 1980, by Pope John Paul II. She was canonized by Pope Francis, on April 3rd, 2014, as the Ursulines celebrated the 375th anniversary of her arrival in Quebec.

Here are **some more ideas** to what to do during **Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Sacred Heart Church Fridays 1:30-6:30pm**

- 1. Promise to trust Him.
- 2. See the Blessed Virgin kneeling next to you, adoring her Son and praying with you.
- 3. Realize that your Holy Guardian Angel is with you. Ask him to coach you in holiness.
- 4. Renew your loyalty to His Church.
- 5. Ask your patron saint to pray for you to know and do God's Will.
- 6. Lean on Him. Tell Him you love Him.
- 7. Thank Him for the Sacraments.
- 8. For a time, don't DO anything. Be with Him, as a friend, while He works.
- 9. Ask Him if that is perhaps what he wants you to "do" more often.
- 10.Tell Him your failures. Ask for help. Then listen.

PARISH NEWS

CELEBRATION OF HOLY MASS ON SUNDAY

We were given permission by our Bishop to have Sunday Mass to be held in the parking lot of Sacred Heart Church at 10:00 a.m., beginning this Sunday, April 25th

-Some important Details:

-all the regulations coming from the Government and the Diocese of Peterborough must be observed; please read carefully and cooperate with us;

-the Mass will be celebrated from the sacristy, at the window facing the parking lot. You will be directed to park facing the large sacristy window; to maximize the space at the parking lot you will be guided to park orderly according to your arrival time (you need to occupy first line first);

-Sound will be transmitted both by a speaker set outside and to your car by a FM radio transmitter. Please tune in to 98.5

-Holy Communion will be distributed to you in your vehicle. Be mindful of the importance and sacredness of the Holy Eucharist so please be as respectful and careful as possible when receiving the Blessed Sacrament in this unusual place; Eucharistic Ministers will approach you in your vehicle and distribute Holy Communion to those who are in the car; receive it in the hands, with your hands inside the vehicle and be careful not to drop the host inside the vehicle; Holy Communion will not be distributed to people inside the Church or people outside the cars;

-To allow space for everyone who wishes to attend Sunday Mass, we encourage you to come with as many people as possible from your social bubble in a single vehicle.

-Please park your vehicle two meters apart from other vehicles and remain in your vehicle during Mass.

-Volunteers are needed to help direct traffic into the parking lot from 9 a.m. Please show yourself to Fr. Salvador for instructions.

Each Saturday morning the system will be updated by the sisters so that you may sign up for Masses of that week. Please sign up for only two Masses a week in order to give everyone a chance to participate in Holy Mass. You might be able to sign up for an additional Mass if spots are being freed during the week, so check the link every day.

CHURCHES OPEN FOR PRIVATE PRAYER

Both Sacred Heart and St. John will be open for private prayer; please sign in as you enter the church in the booklet by the door; and if you see more than 10 people at the door please wait until someone leaves before entering.

The parishes will be open during the following times: Monday to Friday from 10:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. Saturday and Sunday from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

FEAST DAY OF ST. MARIE OF THE INCARNATION

Friday April 30th, is the feast day of St. Marie of the Incarnation. She is the patroness of the community of the Sisters Servants of the Lord and the Virgin of Matara serving at our parishes. A First Class Relic of St. Marie of the Incarnation will be displayed at St. John the Baptist for veneration on Friday April 30th from 10:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.

We would like to invite you to participate in some activities we have organized to honour Mary during this especial month; they can be done from home:

CONSECRATION TO OUR BLESSED MOTHER

We invite you to consecrate yourself and your family to the Blessed Virgin Mary following the method for consecration written by St Louis Maria Grignion de Monfort. The preparation for the consecration takes 33 days; it will begin on the 28th of April and will end on the 30th. The consecration will be on the 31st of May, Feast day of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin to her cousin Elizabeth.

Every day you will need to watch a short video to prepare you for the consecration. We will send the videos every week for you to use:
