Dear Friends,

May is the Month of Mary! As mother's day always fall in May, it is only fitting that the entire month of May should be dedicated to Mary. As Mary is the mother of the Redeemer; in some way every Christian Heart should turn to her in great reverence and love; desiring to always grow closer to her as she helps us to grow closer to Christ. As Saint Louis de Montfort says, "Mary is the safest, easiest, shortest and most perfect way of approaching Jesus." (*True Devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary*)

In this month Mary comes to meet us, she takes us by the hand, to a greater intimate union with her Divine Son, opening up for us the secrets of the Mystery of Faith. Not only does she open her heart to us, but she also helps us to open up our hearts to Christ. As the Gospel of Luke say in

reference to Mary, "and you yourself a sword will pierce so that the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed." (Luke 2:35)

Mary is a mother, similarly to the Good Shepherd, she goes out in search for her lost children and bring them back to the House of the Father. Saint Therese of the Child Jesus also adds, "she is spoken of as unapproachable whereas she should be represented as imitable."

Some practices we can do in order to grow in devotion to Mary; first is to refer to her as 'Mother' – 'Mother Mary' by this we start to build a true spiritual relationship. And lastly, and probably the most powerful practice is to take up the rosary or to pray the rosary in the company of Mary.

GOSPEL John 13.1, 31-33a, 34-35

Jesus said to his disciples: "Whoever loves me will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him. Whoever does not love me does not keep my words; and the word that you hear is not mine, but is from the Father who sent me.

"I have said these things to you while I am still with you. But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything, and remind you of all that I have said to you.

"Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled, and do not let them be afraid.

"You heard me say to you, 'I am going away, and I am coming to you.' If you loved me, you would rejoice that I am going to the Father, because the Father is greater than I. And now I have told you this before it occurs, so that when it does occur, you may believe."

Hail Mary: The prayer known in Latin as the Ave Maria. The first part of the prayer praises God for the gifts he gave to Mary as Mother of the Redeemer; the second part seeks her maternal intercession for the members of the Body of Christ, the Church, of which she is the Mother (CCC 2676).
