PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Friends,

This year on December 27th 2023 – on the feast of Saint John the Evangelist – we celebrate the 350th Anniversary of the first apparition of the Sacred Heart of Jesus to Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque. A devotion that was slowly yet securely revealed to the Church throughout the generations; from Saint John, to Saint Bernard of Clairvaux and Francis of Assisi (who inspired the 5 wound of Jeus devotion), to Saint Gertrude and Saint John Eudes, until the full revelation to Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque.

Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque received 4 major apparitions of the Sacred Heart of Jesus:

1. The First Apparition was on the Feast of Saint John

the Evangelist (Dec. 27th 1673).

2. The Second Apparition was on July 2nd 1674 (which was considered, at that time, the Feast of the Visitation).

- 3. The Third Revelation was on the First Friday of July 1674.
- 4. And the Last Apparition was on the First Friday of June 1675.

It was a total of an 18-month process for the beginning to the end of the revelation of this Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus to be established through Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque. In 1856 in the time of Pope Pius IX the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus was established to be celebrated in the Universal Church on the Friday after the Second Sunday of Pentecost.

This year, in honor of this 350th Anniversary of the Sacred Heart of Jesus − I would like to offer the opportunity to reexperience the Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus as Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque did; highlighting each day of the apparition with a reflection on what occurred during the apparition → we will call it "Reliving the Apparition of the Sacred Heart of Jesus to Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque".
