Dear Friends,

We have come from celebrating great Solemnities and two Sacraments!

It all began on Saturday, May 25th we had Bishop Miehm visit Saint John the Baptist Catholic Church to preside over the Mass of Confirmations on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity.

The following Sunday, June 1st we celebrated the Solemnity of the Most Precious Body and Blood of Christ, and with it the Eucharistic Procession from Sacred Heart Church (*following the 9 AM Mass*) towards Saint John the Baptist Church (*for the 10:30 AM Holy Mass*). At the Holy Mass at Saint John the Baptist six kids received Jesus for the first time in the Most Holy Eucharist; it was great weather and a beautiful Eucharistic Procession! And things didn't end there...on Friday, June 7th, as a finale to the Novena of the Sacred Heart of Jesus (May 29th – June 6th), we had the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus Holy Mass presided by Bishop Miehm at Sacred Heart Church. Although we could not have our

Eucharistic Procession due to weather, God was certainly well pleased to have so many confessions, I would say we easily had over 100 confessions between 9 AM - 5:20 PM. At the conclusion of the Mass, I was able to lead the Parish in the Consecration Prayer to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus and Bishop Miehm gave us the Apostolic Blessing. So many joyful things to celebrate! As the Founder of Our Religious Community (Institute of the Incarnate Word) would say, "From Feast to Feast to the Grand Feast (Heaven)!"
