## PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Friends,

Canada will have a new canonized saint in October! When Blessed Marie-Leonie Paradis is canonized she will be the 15th Canadian saint.

Blessed Sister Marie-Léonie Paradis was born in Quebec, Canada and taught in the United States for several years before returning to Canada. She was born into a poor family in the 19th century and at a very young age she was attracted to religious life. By the age of 13 she was totally convinced in joining the Congregation of the Marianites of the Holy Cross. She was known for her great teaching abilities and was sent to St. Vincent de Paul Orphanage in New York, United States. After several years she then found herself teaching at St. Mary Academy, and ultimately returned back to Canada to help out at the College of Saint Joseph in Memramcook, New Brunswick.

Her joyful example of a religious and the dedication of her teaching attracted many young women to want to work with her in a religious congregation. Bishop Paul Larocque, noticed the great graces God had given her and how many women she was inspiring to the religious life that he encouraged her to found a new religious

congregation who would aid priest and other religious. With the Bishops support, she established the Little Sisters of the Holy Family on May, 31, 1880 (The Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary). Their specific apostolate (focus) was "domestic work in religious communities, colleges and seminaries."

Sister Marie-Léonie Paradis later died on May 3rd, 1912 at the age of 72. At the time of her death the religious congregation had 635 nuns working between Canada and United States; and today there are more than 1,600 religious of the Little Sisters of the Holy Family.

It is very likely that her feast day will be given to her on May 3rd as nearly all the saints' feast day is on the day of their death, as it is also referred to as their 'birth into eternal life.' This new saint of Canada should be a pride of our Country and our Faith! What a blessing it is to have another intercessor for Canada.
