Dear Parish Family,

This weekend, with great joy and thanksgiving, we celebrate a most beautiful moment in the life of our parish: the First Holy Communion of our children. These young members of our community, clothed in innocence and radiant with faith, are receiving Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament for the very first time. What a sacred and powerful gift! As Our Lord said, "Let the children come to me, and do not prevent them; for the Kingdom of Heaven belongs to such as these" (Matthew 19:14). The Eucharist is the source and summit of our Christian life. In Holy Communion, we are united with Christ Himself—Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. Let us pray that this first encounter will
