PASTOR’S MESSAGE

Dear Parishioners,

The greatest of all the mysteries of our faith is the mystery of God: The Father is God. The Son is God. The Holy Spirit is God. We don’t have three gods, but One God and Three Persons. There is ONE God, TWO Processions and THREE Persons.

1- The Son proceeds from the Father by way of **generation**, that’s why we call him SON. This generation is a generation from the intellect, that’s why we call him WORD.

2- The Holy Spirit proceeds from the Father and the Son by way of **spiration**, that’s why we call him HOLY

SPIRIT. This spiration is an spiration from the will, that’s why we call him LOVE.


These two processions are WITHOUT INTERVAL OF TIME, there is not before and after. Jesus does not come after the Father. The Holy Spirit does not come after the Father and the Son. We are in time. God is not.

This is the God we love “with all our heart, with all our soul and with all our strength”. The God we hope to see one day face to face in Heaven.

Today we also celebrate **Father’s Day**. St. Paul writes in Ephesians 3:15, “*I kneel before the Father, from whom every family in heaven and on earth is named.*” Today we give thanks to God for our fathers. We remember their strength, sacrifice, and faithful love. They are an image of the goodness and providence of God the Father in heaven who always care for us. May all fathers be blessed with wisdom, courage, and grace. And may St. Joseph, model of fatherhood, intercede for them always. Amen.
